

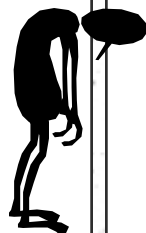

BOARD MEETING UPDATES

June 18, 2008— Regularly Scheduled Meeting

The Private Investigators Licensing Board met on June 18, 2008 for their regularly scheduled meeting. The Board approved: two licenses from individual status to that of qualifying agents for corporations; two new qualifying agents for existing corporations; eight Private Investigator licenses; nine Pri-

ivate Patrolman licenses; two process server licenses and twenty-four corporate officers. One application was continued; and a settlement agreement regarding a discipline matter was approved by the Board. There was a brief discussion referencing the use of Voice Stress Analysis and computer forensic investigations.

The Board directed that the Executive Director continue to move forward with the new Private Investigator and Polygraph Examiner exams and approved the procedures currently in place by Board staff for cash receipts and cash disbursements.

August 13, 2008— Appeal Hearings/Special Meeting

The Private Investigators Licensing Board met on August 13, 2008 for a special meeting. There were six appeal hearings scheduled. The Board approved on corporate private patrolman li-

cense. The corporate license and the qualifying agent's license will be placed into abeyance. Two corporate officers were approved. The Board upheld three of the citations issued, approved a

settlement agreement for one and dismissed one citation. The board approved a new fee schedule and directed the Executive Director to move forward with the new exams.

New Fee Schedule

At the June 2008 meeting, the Board approved the following fee schedule. We will now be charging for duplicate licenses, duplicate id cards, duplicate proof of exam cards and exam booklets.

The Board may charge and collect fees not to exceed:

For the issuance of a duplicate license or for changing the name on a license.....	\$35.00
For the issuance of a duplicate Photo Identification card or for changing the name On the Photo Identification card.....	10.00
For the issuance of a duplicate Pocket Identification card or for changing the name On the Pocket Identification card.....	5.00
For written verification of licensure or an affidavit of license in good standing.....	25.00
For providing a list of persons who are licensed as Private Investigators Private Patrolman, Process Servers, Repossessors, Canine Handlers, Polygraph Examiners or licenses in Abeyance.....	25.00
For providing mailing labels containing the names and addresses of persons who are licensed as Private Investigators, Private Patrolman, Process Servers, Repossessors, Canine Handlers or Polygraph Examiners.....	35.00
For providing a copy of the statutes, regulations and other rules governing the Industries regulated by this State to a person who is not licensed.....	25.00
For each page of records requested pursuant to any public records request.....	25
For each duplicate proof of exam card.....	2.50
For additional exam booklets if habitually requesting replacements due to loss, Damaged etc.....	15.00
